A brief outline of my surgical/clinical experience is given below:

- Performed laser photocoagulation including retinopathy of prematurity
- Performed Photodynamic Therapy for macular diseases
- Performed various intravitreal injections including anti VEGF, Triamcinolone etc
- Performed various types of retinal detachment surgeries including retinal detachment with coloboma, diabetic tractional and combined

- retinal detachment, complicated retinal detachment with PVR, post-traumatic etc.
- Performed Sutureless Vitrectomy and Scleral fixated Intraocular Lenses etc
- ➤ Performed macular surgeries for Macular Hole, Epiretinal membranes etc.

- I was also involved in creating public awareness regarding eye donation and have been involved in harvesting donor corneas and their utilization for corneal transplantation.

It was a health camp conducted by all medical specialists including ophthalmologists. Around 3000-4000 patients were seen over a period of 4 days. We screened and treated them for minor ailments and referred the patients to tertiary hospital for surgeries.
